**POST OFFICE BREAK IN:** As you may know burglars smashed their way into the Post Office, smashed the counter and tore out the safe with all the money and stamps and took all the cigarettes etc. What you may not know is that Preet and Bob have found the Post Office insurance only covers a small proportion of the stamps and Post office cash and they have to repay the Post Office for the rest and the Post Office won't help them to replace the damaged counter and their shop insurance only covers a small proportion of the cigarettes so they've suffered a massive loss Preet said about £20,000 - more than they make in a year and they are absolutely devastated. It's their first business and they've tried so hard. . Tim Lockley is organising a fund raising campaign to help them. Do please also shop with them as much you can. and of course pray for them.
