<sup>31</sup> rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race.

## REFLECTION FROM THE RECTORY

*This Sunday we focus on the Trinitarian nature of God – something that many preachers dread as we are attempting to describe something that cannot be defined, and is ultimately a mystery which defies our attempts to compose a neat and logical description. In the creeds we affirm our belief in God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, but that doesn't mean we really understand how God can be one yet also three persons. We are fooling ourselves when we fall into thinking that we can satisfactorily explain God. Despite our intellectual wrestling with the mystery of his nature, the focus of this Sunday's celebration is on the revelation of God to our world as its creator, on Jesus, who taught us about the boundless love of the God who loved us into life, and on the Spirit who dwells deep within us and frees us from isolation and empowers us to live generously in relationship with others. It is love that is at the centre of our focus on Trinity Sunday. The love of God that led to the creation of all things, and especially of our world, filling it with beauty and wonder. The love that became one of us in the person of Jesus and showed us how to truly love; and the love who is present with us in every moment of our lives in the person of the Spirit. That love is something we can experience and relate to – the metaphysical contortions of attempting to explain the unexplainable are best left to the theologians!*

*May the Love of Jesus fill us, the Holy Spirit guide us, and the will of the Father be done in our lives and in the world.*
