**Judgement before the Ancient One**

## REFLECTION FROM THE RECTORY

Well after the unseasonably warm temperatures recently the wind direction changed this week, and the media were full of warnings about ice and snow. As I write this we are waiting to see if any snow makes it this far south which I doubt, but the prospect of snow brings a mixed reaction from those who love it, to those who dread it. When snow first falls, it covers the world in a mantle of brilliant white. It hides the mud, the grime, and the broken things underneath, offering a fleeting but total sense of purity and newness. The prophet Isaiah captured this image powerfully when speaking of God's forgiveness: "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." Just as the fresh snow offers a world made new, God's grace offers us a clean slate. We are invited to step onto that clean, white page every day. Every single snowflake is a masterpiece—unique, intricate, and perfectly formed. No two are exactly alike. Yet, it is only when countless individual flakes fall together that they form the beauty that transforms the world. Each of us is fearfully and wonderfully made, a unique design from the hand of God. We are called to cherish our own distinct gifts and personalities. But our true power and beauty are only realized when we come together, working in unity, as we too are called to transform the world around us.
